1. Customers go to the booth at the market designated with the yellow "EBT and Debit Cards Accepted Here" banner.
2. They say how much of the 3 Squares VT benefits they would like to spend and then swipe their EBT card.
3. They will be given wooden tokens worth \$1 dollar bill that matches their 3SquareVT purchase, up to \$10 per market day.
4. Crop Cash is then used to purchase fresh fruits, vegetables and herbs at participating farmers markets.

There are over 45 farmers markets in Vermont that accept 3SquaresVT benefits and offer Crop Cash!
